Schools and Districts determine what constitutes a local assessment.

\*\* For grades 9-12, the Science MTAS should be administered when the student completes instruction in the life science standards as determined by the IEP team.

\*\*\* High School MCA-III Science will be administered to all students completing Biology/Life Science credit in the current school year (grades 9-12).
