Speech and Language Therapy

We are continuing our Social Detective journey by looking at *Hidden Rules* within social situations e.g. you quietly put your hand up and ask to go to the toilet rather than announcing it to everyone in the middle of a lesson! These are really tricky skills to learn and we will look at development across different scenarios both in and out of school. Please let us know if there are any situations you know your child struggles to understand the expected behaviours about and we will try to cover this in our learning e.g. touches all the fruit at the shop, goes the wrong way up a slide, tells strangers they smell or makes an observation about how they look.

We will also continue to practice our life skills and will be looking at how we order something in a café and buy things at the shops.
