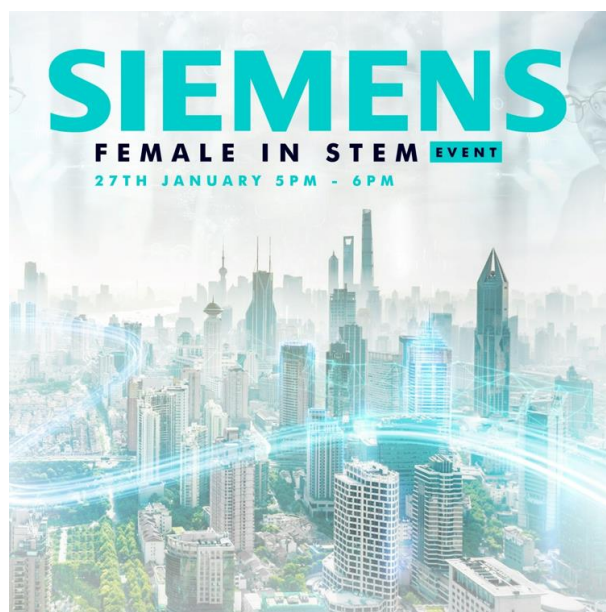


## Y10 – Y13 – Females in STEM/Tech virtual evening, Thur 27 Jan, 5pm – 6pm
