

**Board Minutes**  
**March 17, 2020**

The Johnson County Board of Education met in regular session on Tuesday, March 17, 2020 in the board office at 6:00 p.m. Kevin Brantley, Donald Smith, Chris Fields, Alvin P. Moorman, and Marty Thompson were present. Mr. Brantley called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. Mr. Fields gave the invocation and Mr. Thompson led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The following business was transacted:

1. The proposed agenda was approved on a motion by Mr. Fields, second by Mr. Moorman; unanimous approval.
2. The February 18, 2020 regular meeting minutes were approved on a motion by Mr. Moorman, second by Mr. Fields; unanimous approval.
3. The February 2020 financial report was approved on a motion by Mr. Thompson, second by Mr. Fields; unanimous approval.
4. On a motion by Mr. Moorman, second by Mr. Fields; unanimous approval was given for FY21 budget meetings. They are as follows:

  - June 2, 2020, 6:00 p.m. Budget/Public Hearing
  - June 11, 2020 5:00 p.m. Budget/Public Hearing, adopt Tentative Budget

5. Superintendent Morris discussed in detail the ongoing maintenance/facility projects and the school/safety grants. He then recognized the board members with a certificate for Board Members Appreciation. He thanked them for their dedication to the students, staff, and community. He also shared a list of tips for COVID-19 times from the Georgia School Boards Association.
6. Dr. Christopher Watkins, Middle/High Principal and Superintendent Morris discussed the 2020 Prom with board members. The prom is being postponed due to COVID-19. After a lengthy discussion, it was decided by consensus to table setting a new date until more information was received.

On a motion by Mr. Fields, second by Mr. Smith unanimous approval was given to go into executive session to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee. After discussion, a motion was made to come out of executive session by Mr. Moorman, second by Mr. Thompson; unanimous approval.
