Board Minutes November 15, 2016

The Johnson County Board of Education met in regular session on Tuesday, November 15, 2016 in the board office at 6:00 p.m. Mr. Carter, Mr. Brantley, Mr. Smith, and Mr. Thompson were present. Mr. Carter called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. He also gave a special welcome to the two new board members elect: Mr. Alvin P. Moorman and Mr. Chris Fields. Mr. Thompson gave the invocation and Mr. Brantley led the pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The following business was transacted:

- 1. The proposed agenda was approved on a motion by Mr. Thompson, second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval.
- 2. The September 20, 2016 regular board meeting minutes and the October 18, 2016 regular board meeting minutes were approved on a motion by Mr. Smith, second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval.
- 3. The September 2016 and the October 2016 financial reports were approved on a motion by Mr. Brantley, second by Mr. Thompson; unanimous approval.
- 4. The Resolution for Title 50 Waiver was approved on a motion by Mr. Thompson, second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval. The resolution is attached and becomes a part of these minutes.
- 5. Final approval was given to rescind Policy IDCH concerning dual enrollment on a motion by Mr. Smith, second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval.
- 6. Superintendent Thomas presented a proposal for replacement of twenty projectors at the schools. Replacement will be based on need as determined by the technology department. This first phase of replacements is estimated to cost \$20,000.00 and be paid for with SPLOST funds. This proposal was approved on a motion by Mr. Thompson, second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval.
- 7. The following field trips and fund raising requests were unanimously approved on a motion by Mr. Smith; second by Mr. Brantley:

- 8. Dr. Keith Geter, Assistant Principal, spoke on behalf of the Middle/High School. He informed the board that the graduation rate had increased from 81.8 % in 2015 to 87.5% in 2016. The state average is at 79.2%. He also discussed updates on PBIS, the new camera system and metal detectors, staff and student attendance, and Striving Reader.
- 9. Mrs. Redessa Crawford reported that she will be taking a small group of elementary and high school students to a food show soon. She also discussed using foods grown locally. A new curriculum, *Nutrition Nuggets*, will be introduced to Pre-K in the near future. Also discussed was a flavor station being added at the middle/high school. She stated that she does not think there will be any immediate changes to federal guidelines for school nutrition due to the recent presidential election.
- 10. Superintendent Thomas reported that the recently installed cameras and metal detectors were helpful at both schools. She reported that the renovation project at the middle/high school was nearing completion. Some issues with the painters are being addressed. She also updated the board on the SPLOST budget.
- 11. On a motion by Mr. Brantley, second by Mr. Thompson; unanimous approval was given to go into executive session to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal or periodic evaluation of a public officer or employee. After discussion, a motion was made to come out of executive session by Mr. Thompson, second by Mr. Brantley; unanimous approval.
- 12. Superintendent Thomas presented personnel recommendations. The following recommendations were unanimously approved on a motion by Mr. Smith, second by Mr. Brantley:
