

Board Minutes
March 18, 2014

The Johnson County Board of Education met in regular session on Tuesday, March 18, 2014 in the board office at 6:00 p.m. Donnie Carter, Alan Frost, Bill Jackson, Marty Thompson and Bernard Young were present. Mr. Thompson called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. Mr. Young gave the invocation and Mr. Jackson led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The following business was transacted:

1. The proposed agenda was approved on a motion by Mr. Young, second by Mr. Jackson; unanimous approval.
2. Ellen Hortman was not present to speak.
3. The February 25, 2014 board minutes were approved on a motion by Mr. Frost, second by Mr. Jackson; unanimous approval.
4. The February 2014 financial report was approved on a motion by Mr. Carter, second by Mr. Young; unanimous approval.
5. Superintendent Thomas presented the 2014-2015 school calendar for approval. Calendar was approved on a motion by Mr. Jackson, second by Mr. Frost; unanimous approval. Calendar is attached and becomes a part of these minutes.

7. JCES Principal, Mr. Charles Howard, reported that the 5th grade writing assessments are complete and he hopes to have score results soon. Mr. Howard discussed recent professional learning training held on 3-14-14 and the upcoming Book of the Month. Mr. Howard congratulated elementary students who participated in the Georgia Young Author's Writing Contest and who will be competing at the state level. Mr. Howard also congratulated elementary students who will be participating in a Leadership Conference in Savannah on 3-28-14.
8. JCMHS Principal, Mr. Gary Price discussed in detail the current SACS study being conducted at the high school. Mr. Price also reminded board members that the on-line calendar is a useful tool in keeping up with activities in the school system. Mr. Price reported that Wes Jackson will be attending the STAR student banquet in Thomson and congratulated him on this honor.
9. Superintendent Thomas commended Mr. Price and his staff on their preparedness for the SACS study.
10. Superintendent Thomas read Governor Deal's proclamation of School Board Member Appreciation Week and publically thanked board members for their commitment to the school system and community.
11. Superintendent Thomas presented projected SPLOST 3 expenditures as well as final expenditures on SPLOST 2.
12. Superintendent Thomas reported that the system has been notified that it will not be receiving the 21st Century grant for fiscal year 2015.
13. On a motion by Mr. Thompson, second by Mr. Young; unanimous approval was given to go into executive session to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal, or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee. After discussion, a motion was made to come out of executive session by Mr. Carter, second by Mr. Frost; unanimous approval.

15. Superintendent Thomas recommended Anthony Frost and Rebecca Frost for employment for the 2014-2015 school year. On a motion by Mr. Jackson, second by Mr. Carter; approval was given to hire Anthony Frost and Rebecca Frost. Motion carried with 4 YES votes. Mr. Frost abstained.
