

**Board Minutes**  
**July 31, 2012**

The Johnson County Board of Education met in called session on Tuesday, July 31, 2012 in the board office at 5:30 p.m. Alan Frost, Alvin Moorman, Donnie Carter and Bill Jackson were present. Vice-Chairman Frost welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order.

The following business was transacted:

1. The proposed agenda was approved on a motion by Mr. Moorman, second by Mr. Jackson; unanimous approval.
2. Superintendent Warnock updated the board on the progress of the Call for the SPLOST election.
