

Called Board Minutes

February 25, 2010

A special called meeting of the Johnson County Board of Education was held on Thursday, February 25, 2010 in the Board Room at 5:00 p.m. All board members were present. Board Chairman Moorman called the meeting to order and gave the invocation. Alan Frost led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Upon a motion by Frost and a second by Carter, the agenda was unanimously approved as submitted.
