

Called Board Meeting Minutes

March 30, 2010

The Johnson County Board of Education met in called session on Tuesday, March 30, 2010 in the board office. Chairman Moorman called the meeting to order, welcomed everyone and gave the invocation.

The following business was transacted:

1. The agenda was approved on a motion by Frost, second by Carter; unanimous approval.
2. On a motion by Jackson, Second by Thompson, the board unanimously approved going into executive session to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee.
3. On a motion by Jackson, second by Carter, the board unanimously approved coming out of executive session.
4. Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Cordy, on a motion by Carter, second by Frost, the board unanimously approved accepting the resignation of Rodney Martin effective the end of the 2009-2010 school year and the retirement of Jean O'Mea effective the end of the 2009-2010 school year.
5. Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Cordy, on a motion by Jackson, second by Thompson, the board unanimously approved the employment of Melissa Martin as Mental Health Therapist through the Safe Schools/Healthy Students Initiative Grant.
6. On a motion by Carter, second by Jackson, the board unanimously approved incorporating the March 2010 Trojan Way Newsletter prepared by Superintendent Cordy into the board minutes.
7. On a motion by Jackson, second by Frost, the board unanimously approved not attending the 2010 Georgia School Boards Association Summer Conference and Delegate Assembly this summer due to budget constraints.
