

## **Called Board Minutes**

**May 13, 2010**

The Johnson County Board of Education met in a special called session on Thursday, May 13, 2010 in the board office at 5:00 p.m. All board members were present. Chairman Moorman called the meeting to order. Marty Thompson gave the invocation.

The proposed agenda was approved on a motion by Carter, second by Frost; unanimous approval.

The 2010 – 2011 School Calendar was approved on a motion by Frost, second by Jackson; unanimous approval. Calendar is attached and becomes a part of these minutes.

On a motion by Thompson, second by Frost; unanimous approval was given to go into executive session to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring disciplinary action or dismissal or periodic rating of a public officer or employee. On a motion by Frost and a second by Jackson; unanimous approval was given to come out of executive session.

Superintendent Cordy presented list of certificated personnel for employment for the 2010 – 2011 school year.

On a motion by Frost, second by Carter; unanimous approval was given to hire central office and system-wide employees as presented. List is attached and becomes a part of these minutes.

On a motion by Carter, second by Jackson; unanimous approval was given to hire Johnson County Elementary School employees as presented with the exception of Becky Frost and Mary Beth Thompson. List is attached and becomes a part of these minutes.

On a motion by Jackson, second by Thompson; approval was given to hire Becky Frost for the 2010-2011 school year. Vote was 4 – YES with Frost abstaining due to employee being a family member.

On a motion by Frost, second by Jackson; approval was given to hire Mary Beth Thompson for the 2010-2011 school year. Vote was 4 – YES with Thompson abstaining due to employee being a family member.

On a motion by Frost, second by Thompson; unanimous approval was given to hire Johnson County Middle School employees as presented. List is attached and becomes a part of these minutes.

On a motion by Carter, second by Jackson; approval was given to hire Johnson County High School employees as presented with the exception of Anthony Frost. List is attached and becomes a part of these minutes.

On a motion by Jackson, second by Thompson; approval was given to hire Anthony Frost for the 2010 – 2011 school year. Vote was 4 - YES with Alan Frost abstaining due to employee being a family member.

On a motion by Frost, second by Carter; unanimous approval was given on the following personnel issues as recommended by Superintendent Cordy:

Due to cuts in state funding, Superintendent Cordy noted that two positions at the middle school had been eliminated for the 2010 – 2011 school year. It was further noted that three vacancies at the middle/high school for the 2010 – 2011 school year had previously been filled by transferring existing elementary school staff that were also certified and highly qualified at the middle/high school level. A total of five positions have been eliminated as a result of state funding reductions.
