

Called Board Minutes

January 13, 2010

The Johnson County Board of Education met in a special called session on Wednesday, January 13, 2010 in the board office at 3:30 p.m. All board members were present. Chairman Moorman called the meeting to order. Donnie Carter gave the invocation.

The proposed agenda was approved on a motion by Carter, second by Jackson; unanimous approval.

On a motion by Frost, second by Carter; unanimous approval was given to go into executive session to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring disciplinary action or dismissal or periodic rating of a public officer or employee. On a motion by Frost and a second by Jackson; unanimous approval was given to come out of executive session.
