Paper

cardboard, napkins, paper towels, paper plates, paper cups, coffee filters, newspaper, tea bags

floral trimmings, house plants

baby wipes, diapers, cat litter, pet waste, medicine, styrofoam, glass, yard waste, wood chips, sawdust, cleaning wipes, rubber bands, oil

Why Compost?

Removing kitchen scraps from the Town's waste stream reduces waste hauling and disposal costs.
Our food waste is collected and turned into high quality compost, which returns valuable nutrients to the soil.
