A Regular Meeting of the School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) for China Spring Independent School District will be held January 12, 2022, beginning at 4:30 P.M. in the CSISD Administration Building.

The subjects to be discussed or considered or upon which any formal action may be taken are as listed below. Items do not have to be taken in the order shown in the meeting notice.

1. Welcome 4:30pm
Cindy Davis, Chair, welcomed everyone and introduced herself and her Co-Chair, Lindsey Fox. Everyone introduced themselves.
(Two non-members attended the meeting today: Michael Larson and Andrea Barnett)
*There was an audio issue at the start of the meeting and once it was fixed, Dr. Pitts went back over the discussion that was not on the recording yet.
2. Approval of Last Meeting Minutes
Dr. Pitts discussed the minutes and asked for questions. Lindsey Fox motioned to accept the minutes and Shanna Sanders seconded the motion. The vote to approve the minutes was unanimous.
3. New Business/Reports
 - A. COVID Update: Dr. Pitts discussed the numbers for students and staff with positive COVID tests. The highest number in the fall of total students and staff was 64. He also discussed the RIPICS plan and current numbers of staff and students with positive COVID tests: 99 total.
Mr. Larson spoke about some concerns he has with the district's response to COVID. He stated he would like to see the district be more vocal in strongly encouraging vaccinations and in modeling mask wearing. Nurse Ellis explained what she is seeing at the high school level. Dr. Pitts explained the vaccination clinics, stated that we have had the most successful clinics in the area, and have had 984 vaccinations through these clinics. Dr. Pitts expressed his gratitude to Mr. Larson and let him know that he would bring those concerns to Dr. Faulkner and to the board.
 - B. Child Nutrition: Dr. Pitts explained that we are putting out an RFP to rebid for food services. As soon as we get back the RFP from TDA, we will need to put it in the paper and go through the process of hiring a FSMC. Mary Ann Kaminski discussed the SSO and the fact that students are getting free food this year. She also let the

- members know that they are having some supply chain issues but are making minor changes to accommodate this.
- C. Campus Safety: Officer Sanders stated that this spring we will have to conduct an intruder assessment. The intermediate has transitioned to a new student check out system.
 - D. Social Services Liaison:
 - a. Mental Health Cindy Davis expressed that the district is serious about providing what students need in regards to mental health. There is a resource fair coming to the district in April and parent summits monthly throughout the remainder of the semester.
 - b. Parent Summits Bianca Martinez shared that the first Parent Summit will be on suicide prevention and coping skills and will be here on January 31, 2022. It will also be streamed live for anyone who wants to watch virtually. The invite has gone out through the district email and social media. Bianca Martinez will send the invite to the elementary to go in Seesaw for parents.
4. Curriculum:
- a. Health/Physical Education
 - b. Human Sexuality-House Bill 1525
Jennifer Crook stated that the Texas standards (TEKS) are what we teach for health and for human sexuality and lessons are in google docs.
Jerry Niles moved to accept the health instruction as presented at the last meeting. Cindy Davis seconded, and the vote to accept the health instruction was unanimous.
Jerry Niles made the motion to accept the human sexuality instruction as presented at the last meeting. Ashley Havard seconded the motion, and the vote to accept the motion was unanimous.
5. Discussion of future Agenda Items: There are new requirements for the SHAC meetings. We will create bi-laws in the future. There will be more information for the Parent Summits at the next meeting. We may discuss what we can get ready for the beginning of the school year in SHAC meetings.

7. Adjourn Cindy Davis moved to adjourn the meeting. Heather Jenkins seconded the motion to adjourn. The vote to adjourn the meeting was unanimous.
