- ✓ completion of summer assignments(s)
- ✓ demonstration of excellent class attendance; and
- ✓ demonstration of the ability to manage out-of-class time effectively

I understand the standard in GT or Honors course(s) is that work be submitted by established deadlines(s);

I understand that I will be expected to maintain a high level of academic integrity;

To exit a GT or Honors course, I must follow the exit policy and my parent(s)/guardian(s) must have a parent-teacher conference;

I understand that a GT or Honors teacher may recommend my removal from GT or Honors classes if my average falls below 70 at the end of the first three weeks, at the end of the first six weeks, or at the end of the first semester;

I understand that I must earn a grade of 70 or higher to receive credit for a GT or Honors course. If a grade below 70 is earned for the year in GT or Honors ELAR, Math, Science, or Social Studies, the course will need to be retaken for credit;

I understand failure to pass any GT or Honors course(s) at the end of the school year will result in a review by the campus/district GT coordinator to determine probation/furlough or dismissal.
