ELIGIBILITY

Requirement A

Pass the most recent CA ELA Assessment with *Standard Met or Above*

Requirement B

Complete four years of English with an overall GPA of 2.0 or above

Requirement C

Demonstrate proficiency in a language other than English through ONE of the following methods:

- Pass a World Language Advanced Placement exam with a minimum score of a 3
- Pass the International Baccalaureate examination with a minimum score of a 4
- Pass the SAT II World Language Exam with a score of 600 or higher
- Successfully complete a four-year course of study (equivalent to taking level 4 or higher) in world language with a minimum GPA average of 3.0 *AND* passing an Oral Exam

Requirement D

Demonstrate proficiency on the English Language Proficiency Assessment California (ELPAC)

***Latin students or qualifying students of languages not taught at TUSD will complete an alternate assessment.**
