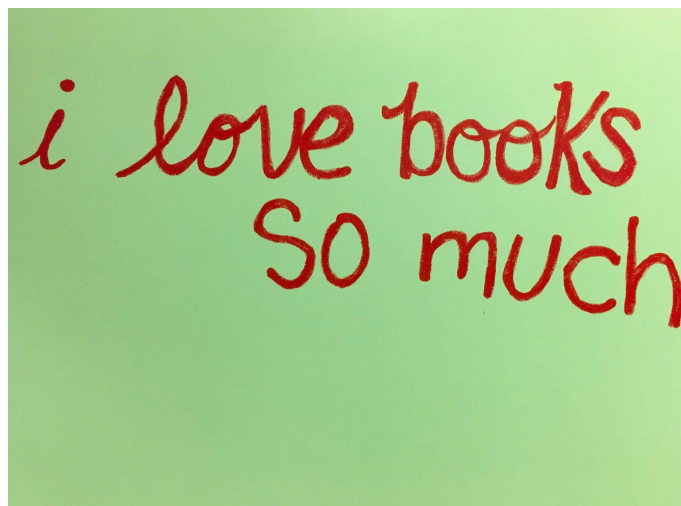


Dear Bridge Point Families,
