<p><u>Authority</u></p> <p><u>Delegation of Responsibility</u></p> <p><u>Guidelines</u></p>	<p>The Board may grant credit towards high school graduation for course work successfully completed through approved alternative delivery methods for instruction such as summer school courses, correspondence courses, distance learning, Internet, dual enrollment, alternative education and other forms of alternative course work in accordance with adopted policy.</p> <p>The building principal shall be responsible for reviewing and approving student applications for earning credit towards graduation through alternative delivery methods for instruction.</p> <p>Per the guidelines outlined in the Program of Studies, the building principal shall determine the number of credits assigned to such a course as part of the approval process before the student begins the course.</p> <p>Students shall request in writing to the building principal approval of the proposed course and number of credits sought.</p> <p>The student shall receive the same letter grade for high school credit that is assigned by the alternative education resource.</p> <p>The assigned grade for successfully completed work shall not be weighted for purposes of computing the student's grade point average, unless prior approval has been granted by the building principal before the course work was begun.</p> <p>Parents, guardians and students are responsible for all fees, including tuition, textbooks and supplies, for courses taken through an alternative delivery method for instruction.</p>
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
