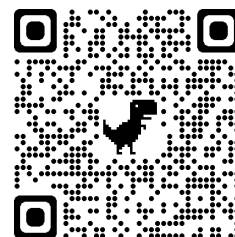

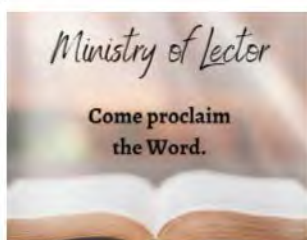
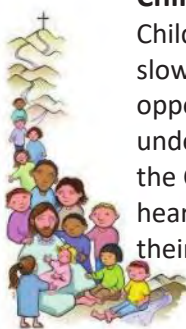

**Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic School, established in 1957, is a parish preschool, elementary and middle school with approximately 500 students.** The Virginia Catholic Education Association (VCEA) has accredited OLGC School since 1972. OLGC School is also a member of the National Catholic Education Association (NCEA) and has been awarded U.S. Department of Education Blue Ribbon School status.

The School provides a Catholic education instilled with the spirituality of St. Francis de Sales. It is intended to "make your child's faith a living, conscious, and active one through the light of instruction." The integration of religious truth and values with life is the focal point of the curriculum. As part of its educational program, OLGC School strives for academic excellence, encourages appreciation of the fine arts, fosters self-respect and respect for all life, and attempts to develop responsibility for the total community.

There are 18 classrooms, a computer lab, science lab, multi media center, music room, band room, art room, academic support center, foreign language room, math rooms, gymnasium, cafeteria, elementary playground, preschool playground, and playing fields. OLGC students have access to the following technology: the school-wide network, the Internet, desktop

and laptop computers, iPad tablets, LCD and document projectors, wireless access, and interactive whiteboards. All middle school students are issued an iPad with keyboard or Chromebook for home and classroom use.

Sixth graders got back to work in the Science Lab last week! They simulated mining for natural resources by trying to remove raisins from gelatin with little disturbance to the gelatin.

**SEASONED CITIZENS** – The next luncheon for OLGC seniors will be held on Thursday, February 10 at Noon in De Sales Hall. The Book Swap Table will be open. Bring a book or two or a jigsaw puzzle (nothing else, please), and feel free to take items that interest you. Mother Nature is always unpredictable, but it seems February is the month she can churn things up in a major way. Keep in mind that OLGC observes the Fairfax County Public Schools guidelines regarding closures, so there's always the possibility the event could be canceled. **BONE HEALTH** – Do you suffer from joint pain, arthritis, or weak bones? Find out what contributes to these conditions, and learn strategies to reduce pain and keep your bones healthy for the long term. This lecture, presented by Dr. Katie Thompson of the Health Improvement Center, will take place this Tuesday, January 25, from 10:00-1:00 pm at the Vienna Community Center. It's offered by Vienna Parks and Recreation to mature adults, and there is no charge.

**A NEW WAY TO NAVIGATE** – An innovative "white cane" can assist blind and visually impaired users in navigating inside buildings and avoiding obstacles. The improved robotic cane now has a 3D camera, onboard computer, and an inertial measurement sensor. When the device has a building's architectural drawing, it can map the user's precise location in the existing architectural drawing or floor plan and accurately guide users to their chosen location. The cane provides both auditory and sensory cues; In addition, it concurrently helps users avoid running into things like chairs, cabinets, boxes, and overhangs. The cane has the ability to easily switch between its "automated mode" and a simpler non-robotic "white cane mode."

The National Institutes of Health's National Eye Institute and the National Institute of Biomedical Imaging and Bioengineering co-funded the development of the device. Cang Ye, Ph.D. and colleagues added the color depth camera so its infrared light, along with the system, could determine the distance between the cane and other objects. This corrected an issue with earlier versions that could guide users to their destination. However, if used for long distances, the inaccuracies in the user's location could mount, eventually leaving the user at an incorrect location.

A few flaws are being worked out before it's market-ready. However, this could be a useful tool in helping provide independence for the blind and visually impaired. You can

**THE DINNER PARTY** – In Neil Simon's farcical take on love, marriage, divorce, and what comes after, six strangers are invited to a mysterious dinner party. They don't know who the other guests will be or why they've been invited. Tossed together in a private dining room, they have a sneaking suspicion that this unorthodox dinner party will forever change their lives. Sound interesting? You can see this play, presented by the Vienna Theatre Company, on January 28, 29, and February 4 and 5 at 8 pm at the Vienna Community Center. There will also be matinee performances at 2 pm on Sundays, January 30 and February 6. Tickets are \$15 and can be purchased online by visiting [viennava.gov/webtrac](http://viennava.gov/webtrac) or in person at the Center.

**A NEW FRAUD TWIST** – Are you getting text messages on your phone from the Parcel Sorting Center asking you to click on a link? That's a package delivery scam, most likely. Crooks often will guide you to a nefarious website where they request personal information, like a credit card or Social Security number – to "verify" that a package being delivered is yours. If you're having issues with a package that you legitimately ordered, go directly to the merchant you ordered it from and request a tracking number. (AARP Bulletin)

And speaking of fraud, keep in mind that despite the growth of email and social media fraud, phone call scams still caused a higher median loss to adults age 60+ who reported incomes to the Federal Trade Commission last year. These are the five most common methods of contact used by shady people: Phone calls were #1. Mail was #2 followed by text messages. Email came in fourth (surprise!), followed by social media. So, it's wise for you to monitor your Caller ID, don't pick up if you don't recognize the name or number. If it's a legitimate call, they'll leave a message.

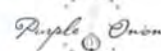
