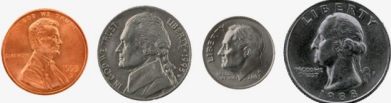
Math:

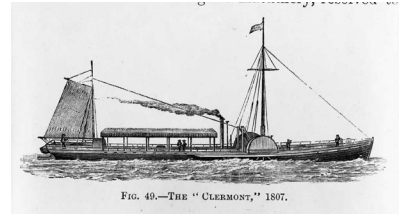
