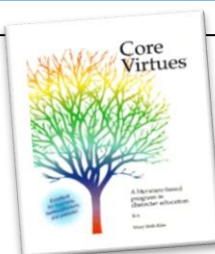
January Core Virtue:

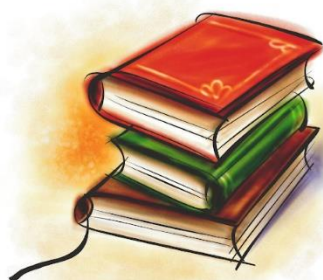

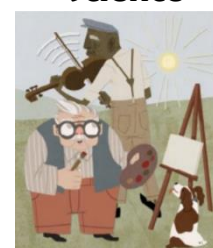


Math

Parent/Teacher Conferences

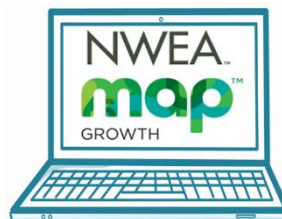
