Quarantining Protocols

Student tests positive-10 day quarantine

Close Contact (vaccinated)- no quarantine required if no symptoms

Close Contact (unvaccinated)-7 day quarantine with a negative PCR test/10 day quarantine with no test

Students are eligible for remote access to instruction if they have tested positive or if they are a close contact to someone that has tested positive. Please contact the main office if this situation occurs for your student. Remote instruction looks different this year—those approved students will be able log in and observe the class. It is not expected that the teacher interact all day with any student on remote.
