**Student tests positive**-10 day quarantine

**Close Contact (vaccinated)**- no quarantine required if no symptoms

**Close Contact (unvaccinated)**-7 day quarantine with a negative PCR test/10 day quarantine with no test



Students are eligible for remote access to instruction if they have tested positive or if they are a close contact to someone that has tested positive. Please contact the main office if this situation occurs for your student. Remote instruction looks different this year--those approved students will be able log in and observe the class. It is not expected that the teacher interact all day with any student on remote.
