All students will have an opportunity to record their minutes at school, but you are welcome to use the Beanstack tool at home anytime your child reads.

Students can access Beanstack on the web or through the Beanstack app. For web access, students can log into their Clever account and click on the Beanstack link. If you prefer the app, students will log-in with their SBISD username which is the first part of their SBISD email, NOT their student ID number (ex: JOHNSMEGooo) and their birthdate (MMDDYY)


Polar Express Bingo


