Graduation Requirements from the Program of Studies.

| Subject | Required Credits | Required Courses |

| English | 4 | English 9, English 10, English11 or AP Language and Composition, English 12 or AP Literature and Composition |
| Social Studies | 3 | -Government or AP United States Government and Politics -United States History or AP United States History -World History or AP World History |
| Science | 3 | -Biology *Conceptual Physics and Chemistry I are Prerequisites |
| Mathematics | 3 All students shall enroll in a mathematics course each year of high school. | -Two credits of Algebra -One credit of Geometry The fourth course must be 1 credit in duration and may be selected from the Program of Studies Mathematics course offerings. |

Additional Graduation Requirements:

- 75 service-learning hours
- A minimum of 25 credits
- A minimum of 4 credits beyond the junior year and 4 years of high school beyond the 8th grade.





Other Important Information

Credits to advance to the next grade:

- 6 Credits Sophomore
- 12 Credits Junior
- 18 Credits Senior + 55 hours of Service Learning

Eligibility for extracurricular activities

- NO “F’s” for quarter grades
- Need a 2.0 weighted GPA for that quarter

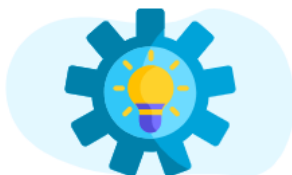
