Supplement Raised from 5.5% to 8% for DCS Certified Staff

Last week at the Davie County Board of Commissioners Meeting, the 2022-2027 Interlocal Agreement was approved, and the Davie County Schools Board of Education subsequently adopted the agreement in their monthly meeting.

The Interlocal Agreement will support funding to increase Davie County Schools certified staff supplements from 5.5% to 8%. This significant increase is the first supplement increase in 15 years. This is in addition to increases that will be seen with the new state budget, which provides funding to increase compensation for all school employees.

The Davie County Board of Education and district leadership have worked to implement the increase immediately, and the supplement will be paid out in the next supplement payment in June 2022. Davie County Schools will pay the 8% supplement out of the current local budget. The supplement will continue annually based on the Interlocal Agreement.

“This has been a true team effort and collective work between our Board of Commissioners, Board of Education, and leadership team, to support our staff,” said Superintendent Jeff Wallace in a video announcement to staff. “Thank you to all Board of Commissioners and Board of Education members for your dedication to our DCS staff, and for your support and leadership. This is an announcement to celebrate! Together we have partnered for the common good of all and the common goal to maintain the value for education and children.”

Davie County Schools (DCS) serves Pre-K and K-12 students in the Piedmont Triad, just west of Winston-Salem. DCS includes 6 elementary schools, 3 middle schools, Davie County High School, Davie County Early College High School, Central Davie Academy, and Davie County Virtual School with a mission to engage, equip, and empower students.
