AB 1808

AB 1808 added Section 216 to the California *Education Code* and provided funding to ensure school staff were prepared to identify, support, and refer middle and high school students who may be experiencing thoughts of suicide

The bill also called for the training to be offered to middle and high school students

AB2246

- School districts serving 7th-12th grades students need to have comprehensive suicide policy in place that includes how they are going to train their staff in suicide prevention each year
- LivingWorks Start provides an additional training option for districts to meet the requirements of AB 2246

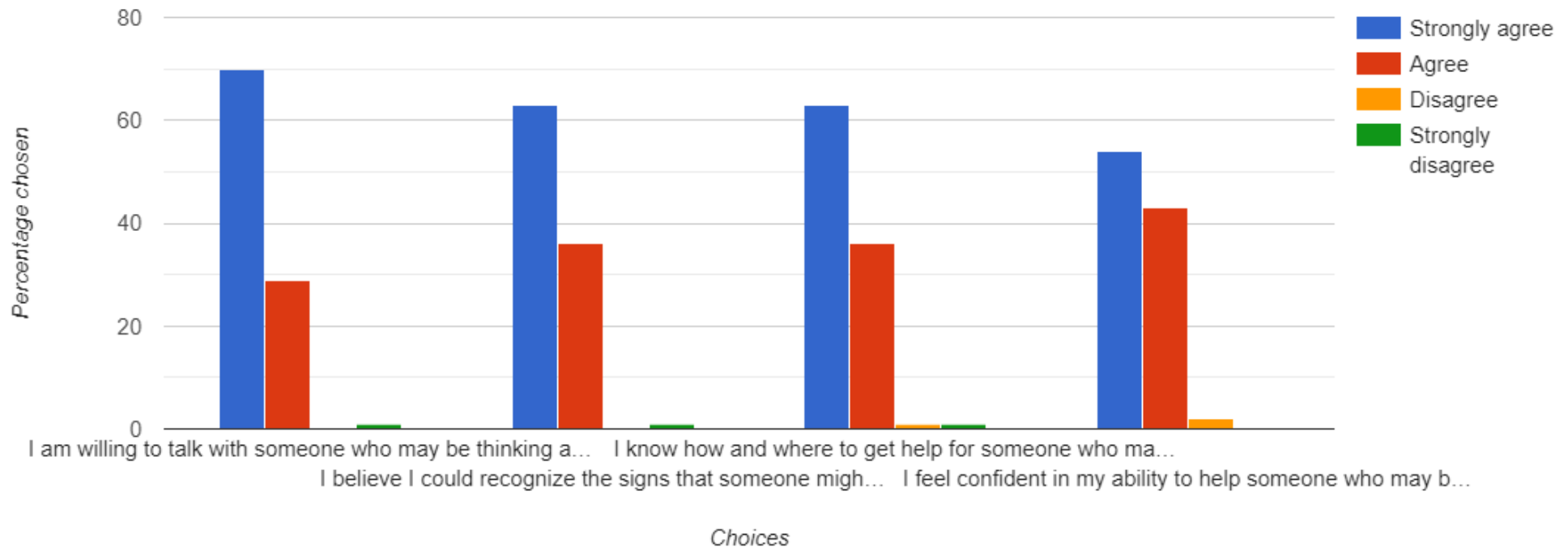
