The Strategic Plan for St. Mark's Episcopal School was adopted by the Board of Trustees in May of 2019. After a year of work, where do we stand now? How has the current climate impacted our goals? We're pleased to provide a brief overview of this important work in the life of our school.

We launched the 2019-20 school year by forming four task forces to lead the efforts at addressing each of our four strategic goals. Each task force has two leaders and a team of about 8 faculty and staff members.
