#### A. How To Prepare

- Students interested in applying for the Early College and Career High School Program are recommended to:
  - 1. Take the PSAT exam in Middle School
  - 2. 7th/8th Grade Students should enroll in at least 1 Pre-AP class (PAP ELA / PAP Math)
  - 3. 7th/8th Grade Students should enroll in Spanish I for High School Credit

#### **B. When Entering High School**

- Be an incoming 9th grade student
- Submit an application through Apply Texas
- Attend Summer Bridge Program (required)
- Enroll in the TSI Prep Class and take the TSIA Exam
- Enroll in Spanish Prep Class
