

Preparing for an IT degree while still in high school

Great Oaks has partnered with the University of Cincinnati to give high school students a head start toward a Bachelor of Science in Information Technology (BSIT) degree.

Students can complete the first year of the BSIT program (9 Early IT classes) with a grade of C or above prior to graduating high school; those students who do so will receive automatic admission to UC's School of Information Technology.
