Learning Modes and Teams

Freshman/sophomore students will first choose their preferred mode of learning, or *how* they want to learn. There are two choices – school-based or online. For students who choose school-based, they can select a traditional day with six periods or a flexible day. From here, 9th graders are placed on teams for their four core courses to foster strong relationships among students and teachers and support high school success.
