



## SCHOOL NEWS

### COVID-19 Community Update

The Davis Waldorf School is committed to keeping our community healthy in the ongoing pandemic. The DWS administration will continue to monitor changing county, state, and national health guidelines as we weather the current holiday surge in C-19 cases. We appreciate our community's abundant caution and urge families to remain mindful of C-19 symptoms.

Any student or staff member who experiences **symptoms of COVID-19** is required to isolate off campus until a negative C-19 test result is obtained and symptoms have improved. So far our students and staff have experienced only a handful of positive cases, and the office is conducting careful contact tracing so that we can stay ahead of and prevent any internal transmission within our community.

## Re-Enrollment for the 2022-2023 School Year

Greetings current DWS families! Re-Enrollment is just around the corner, and so we wanted to start sharing important information and deadlines as soon as possible.

### WHERE Can You Re-Enroll?

We will be transitioning our Enrollment Contracts and Student Information Services away from BigSIS and to Blackbaud - the same company that manages SMART, our tuition management service.

By transferring to a single company for these multiple services, our families will be able to access all of their important documents, payments, and records through one portal. More information on this transition will be shared in the coming weeks.

### WHEN Can You Re-Enroll?

- **Re-Enrollment Contracts** will be available digitally through Blackbaud on **Monday, February 7th.**
- The deadline to sign these contracts and ***pay a reduced enrollment fee*** is **Wednesday, February 16th.**

## IMPACTED CLASSES

Many of our classes are impacted this year, meaning they are at capacity and/or we expect to receive more applications than available spots.

**Impacted classes are as follows:** Preschool (All Programs), Kindergarten, rising 1st Grade (Class of 2030), rising 2nd Grade (Class of 2029), rising 4th Grade (Class of 2027), rising 5th Grade (Class of 2026), and rising 7th Grade (Class of 2024).

**Enrollment spots are considered reserved for currently enrolled students until February 16th. After that date, we will not be holding spots without a signed contract.** Enrollment will open to siblings of enrolled students and newly accepted families starting on February 17th. Applications for 2022-23 are currently being accepted.

## WITHDRAWING

If your family's plans change after signing the Re-Enrollment Contract, **you have until June 30th, 2022 to inform the office by written notice of your withdrawal for the coming school year.** Tuition payments for the 2022-2023 school year will begin in July. If the office receives notice of withdrawal after June 30th, 6 weeks of tuition will be required (tuition weeks are weeks school is in session).



## Tuition for the 2022-2023 School Year

At the December Board meeting, after consultation with faculty and the community, the Board of Directors approved a 3% tuition increase for the 2022-23 school year. This will enable DWS to:

- Provide a cost-of-living salary increase for all employees and annual teacher salary increases of approximately \$36,000
- Manage our rising operational costs due to inflation
- Continue to offer our students an inspirational, varied Waldorf program and invest in redeveloping our campus
- Maintain a robust tuition assistant program

## Additional Fees

**SMART Tuition Processing Fee:** \$50, one-time payment for the year.


**Enrollment Fee (non-refundable):**

- BEFORE Feb. 16th deadline: \$300 per family, (\$200 for preschool-only families)
- AFTER Feb. 16th deadline: \$500 per family, (\$300 for preschool-only families)

**Class Fund Fee\*:**

- Preschool: \$300
- Kindergarten: \$300
- Grades 1 - 4: \$300
- Grades 5 - 8: \$350

*\*Class Funds are used to cover class field trips, additional class materials, and any other class needs that arise over the course of the year.*



## Tuition Assistance Program (TAP)

Our goal at DWS is to make Waldorf education accessible to all families who wish to have it. We recognize an independent, socially- and environmentally-conscious education requires a significant financial commitment.

Each year, DWS budgets a set amount of financial assistance through our Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) to achieve that goal. DWS utilizes a third party company called Tuition Aid Data Service (TADS) to gather financial data, put together reports summarizing this data, and to calculate a family's ability to pay. For the 2021-22 School Year, we have 29 families utilizing the TAP program with a total of \$152,503.79 in tuition assistance being provided.

The application process includes several steps, which include submitting tax returns and current pay stubs, along with other financial documents. **TAP Awards DO NOT roll over, so current families who wish to utilize this resource for the 2022-23 School Year must apply AGAIN and submit updated financial records.** Using TADS helps our school ensure consistency and objectivity in evaluating financial data. 

## UPDATE: June Bug Aftercare Program
