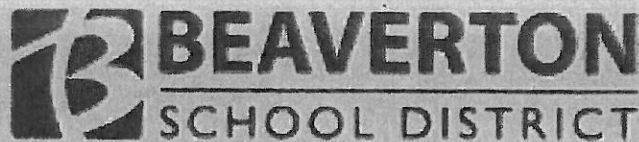

Under the proposed changes, Southridge's poverty rate will double, as measured by the number of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch. In 2013-14, the rate was 25%; under the new boundaries it will be 50%. Meanwhile, the shiny new high school that my tax dollars help pay for will have a poverty rate of only 25%. Also, Southridge's Asian population will be cut by 2/3, from 14% to 5%. (My daughter is Asian). I am concerned with the huge disparity in the district - with 3 schools having mostly more economically advantaged families and 3 schools having ~~the~~ the opposite. This is not why I support the district by voting yes on every school

bond measure.

Transition Comment: Dear Boundary Advisory Committee

We live in the area surrounded by Southwest Walnut Street, Scholls Ferry Road and Southwest 135th Avenue. In the original Springboard map, our area belonged to South Cooper Mountain High School, but at the next Advisory committee, only our small area was moved to Southridge High School. This change means our children who moved from Japan just last year and newly enrolled and adjusted well at Nancy Ryles Elementary will not be able to attend the same high school with most of their current classmates at Nancy Ryles. Under this circumstance, we might have to consider moving or request transfers. It seems to me our area's change was caused mostly by the changes in the northern part of the school district. I believe the first Springboard proposal was created with elementary school boundaries in mind.

However, the revised proposal splits students who attend Nancy Ryles, and I think it is due to the domino effects from the northern area schools. Please be considerate of elementary school boundaries when you create new high school boundaries. I do not mean to make suggestions regarding other high school boundaries, but please change our area back to South Cooper Mountain High School.
