Question / Comment: Request to move consideration area #3 to nearest schools of either Westview or Sunset.

Reasons

- ① Keep neighborhood unity - Keeping Elmonica together. Keeping Elmonica a Title I school. Kids have a strong sense of community. They grow up together both in and out of school, do the same activities, form life long friendship & bond. No ties to kids who will be going to AHS. Makes sense to either remain at WV or ^{from peers} move to Sunset, the 2 most closest schools. Students when separated undergo emotional strain.
 - ② Proximity - All of the houses/condos within #3 fall within the walking radius of either WV or Sunset and in some cases both. Today kids can bike to these schools safely. Lots of sidewalks & bike paths. Going to Aloha has TV Hwy crossing (rated top 3 dangerous intersection across Oregon), max station, nature trails etc which render the path unsafe. Distance wise it is 3x the distance to go to AHS than our closest schools of WV or Sunset.
 - ③ Transportation cost - Along with the 3x increase in distance, increases cost of transportation. Parents need to drive more distance each way to cater to school and/or after school activities. Also this increases time for school bus also. Most parents and students due to travel time & cost will skip activities affecting overall rounded growth.
- In summary puts students first - their mental health, academic and overall growth along with their peers is more important than being 90% or 92%.

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Thank you.

#3 area has only 130 students. Westview can easily accommodate it. If it can today it can tomorrow. The projected growth #'s as pointed out by several community members in August is flawed and ~~also~~ has a 15-20% error rate.

Please consider keeping the Elmonica community together and reallocate us to either Westview or Sunset as this would satisfy neighborhood unity, proximity, safety, equity, transportation cost.

schools of either Sunset or Westview.

Easy ways to reduce WV population

— Stop giving transfers to WV. AP is not a difficulty criteria per
administrative transfer. Every year ~100 students are given
transfers.

— BSD to request for atleast 6 months of proof of address. Many
parents provide friends address, rent an apartment for 2 months
for the sake of address and join Westview. Most of these are false.
A thorough check will show that ~25-30 students join every year
this way.

— Oak hills is closest to Sunset among all the areas. Do not
split oak hills and put the entire oak hills to Sunset. This
makes a lot of sense. It is just a stones throw away from Sunset.
Why assign it to Westview? Moving it away from Westview will
free up ~250 students from Westview. This is more than
enough to free up allocation for #3 and have a spare capacity
of ~100. Oak hills feeds into Meadow Park which feeds into Sunset.
So it should be a natural decision.

- Revise the 2020 projection as it has a $\sim 15\%$ over projection. If these #'s are revised, both Sunset & Westview can easily accommodate area #3.

Westview Open House Speech

(Ask for them not to use the timer.)

(Introduction)

Hi. My name is Elizabeth and I have two children in BSD schools, including one here at Westview.

I am speaking tonight, not just for my neighbors standing behind me, but also for the almost 600 people from our neighborhood who signed the petition we previously gave to the boundary committee and Superintendent Rose.

We live here. (point, turn map to audience) This is our neighborhood, which is one of the areas of consideration, Area 4. (Turn back.)

Thank you. Thank you for being here tonight and for listening to the community. Most of all, thank you and your team for considering keeping us in the Westview boundary. We absolutely support returning Area 4 to Westview, not just because we love Westview, but because it follows all the criteria from policy JC.

(We are Wildcats - intro to criteria)

As early as kindergarten, when our kids join Westview little league teams, they are taught to be proud Wildcats. And they are. We all are. Westview is part of our community and our neighborhood is part of Westview. Did you know that Westview football teams from peewee all the way to 8th grade, practice at Five Oaks Middle School, which is located in our neighborhood? We would absolutely love to stay at Westview. But we realize that loving your school and living in the community where your school is located isn't enough to keep you there. The decision must follow the school board's criteria.

When the recommendation was presented to the board, board members discussed whether or not neighborhood unity or any other criteria needed to be reconsidered. They voted unanimously that the only criteria needing further consideration were proximity to school and transportation. Mr. Sparks, you pointed out that any changes to the map will also need to fit the other criteria. We agree, and we will show you how moving Area 4 back into Westview does indeed fit all criteria.

First, **Availability of Space**

- We know there is room for us here at Westview, because we've seen it on many boundary committee maps. Keeping our students in Westview, without making any other adjustments to the current proposal, still lowers the capacity at Westview by almost 11% from today's enrollment. If this isn't low enough, we ask that adjustments be made that follow the primary criteria so there is room for Area 4. As you can see on this map, the current proposal includes large numbers of students in the Westview boundary who live much closer to Aloha than we do.
- Also, our neighborhood only has 53 potential high school students. That's an average of 13 students per grade level! It would be easy to fit us in either of our two closest schools, which would follow the proximity to school criteria.

(**Proximity to School**)

- This map, created by the district, shows how close neighborhoods are to each of the high schools. Every house and apartment in our neighborhood is inside circles surrounding Westview. **Every. Single. One.** In contrast, not a single house or apartment in Area 4 is in any of the circles surrounding Aloha.
- Of all the areas of consideration, ours is the farthest away from Aloha, the closest to Sunset and the closest to Westview. Keeping us in Westview would clearly satisfy the proximity to school criteria. So would assigning us to Sunset.

Neighborhood Unity

- We realize that full elementary and middle school alignment would be ideal, but according to the board's descriptions of neighborhood unity, neighborhoods in Area 4 have been and continue to be considered one united neighborhood by the district. It's why we're a separate area of consideration.

Safety

- My high schooler has had to walk home from Westview several times. It's a safe route that keeps him on sidewalks and marked and lighted crosswalks the entire way. Safe walking routes also exist from Area 4 to Sunset. Aloha is almost twice as far as Westview and three times as far as Sunset.

Transportation

- Obviously, the closer a student is to their school, the better. It means lower transportation costs for the district and lower costs for families driving back and forth over the years. Rider times would also be lower for our students if you send them to one of their two closest schools. Extra time on in traffic adds up over the course of a school year, so when more than one option exists to send a student to a closer school, the criteria supports doing so.

Finally, Student Body Configuration

- This is important and should be considered. We strongly believe in equity and we love our incredibly diverse neighborhood and district. Every student in the BSD should have equal opportunities to thrive at each of our great BSD schools. However, the student body configuration criteria should not supercede the other criteria, especially proximity to school, on which so many other criteria depend.
- As shown by the data provided in your August 15 analysis, keeping our students in Westview has ZERO effect on the FRL rates at Westview and only makes a 1% difference at Aloha. That's less than the margin of error. Other options exist that we believe would have the same effect on Aloha's FRL rate, while following all other criteria. One option even keeps a whole elementary school from being split.

Superintendent Grotting, we are thrilled that you are considering changing the map to keep Area 4 in Westview, and we hope you will do so. Because we live so close to not one, but two high schools, please change the map so that our 53 students are assigned to one of their two closest schools, which we hope is Westview. Thank you.
