I want to be more involved with school, and I'm sure my siblings too would push to take after school activities. But being that far would make time management difficult, balancing homework, activities, and personal life. Our parents push us to do more, to take AP, to do clubs, but with the distance it wouldn't help at all with encouraging us to do more. I was hoping to start driving soon, but with the long route and dangerous busy roads, I don't think I will be wanting to put myself in that situation. I'm sure my siblings would think the same. Going to Aloha wouldn't only disrupt my parents tight commute schedule between

taking us to school and going to work, but it would disrupt our community. We rarely go to the aloha area. All our places for shopping, summer activities, playdates, and volunteer services are in the westview area. Aloha is far from our usual driving distance. Going to Aloha just seems very misplaced. Transitioning from 2 different schools was hard for me, and I don't want to go through it again, especially now in my final and most important years of highschool. I would like to stay where I started, but as far as my 2 little siblings go, Sunset would be just as fine as westview. But don't move us to Aloha. previous proposed maps & my neighborhood  
has always been in either the Westview  
or Sunset boundaries, until the map that was  
proposed on 2-12-16. My neighborhood has now  
been moved to Aloha H.S. Boundaries.

My neighborhood is 1.3 miles from Sunset  
& 2.8 miles from Westview. Aloha is almost  
double that @ 5 miles. I know one of the criteria  
is transportation & safety. With the proposed  
map, we would be required to drive through  
the Westview boundaries to attend Aloha. We  
would also be required to cross the MAX line  
& RR tracks.


Another concern is that the current proposal  
would divide our church. Our church is

divided by boundaries, this change takes my neighborhood & my kids out of the high schools that all the youth in our stake attend - all attend either Westview or Sunset.

There are hundreds of kids that attend seminary classes, offered as a release time during school hours & school activities. We would be a very small group that would not be unified with the others if we are moved to Aloha. Not having this daily contact would make it harder for our kids to make connections with the ~~kids~~ W-V & Sunset kids as they attend weekly meetings, camps & other activities.

I have a new proposal: Heritage Park area is closer to Aloha boundaries. My proposal would be to move Heritage Park into Aloha boundaries. Then, move Waterhouse, Stonegate, Hunters Run, Weysemer & Merewood back into Westview boundaries. We are a small group of 53 kids

I hope that you will take this proposal & my concerns & use them in your final decision making of H.S. boundaries. Thank you for your time & efforts in this matter.

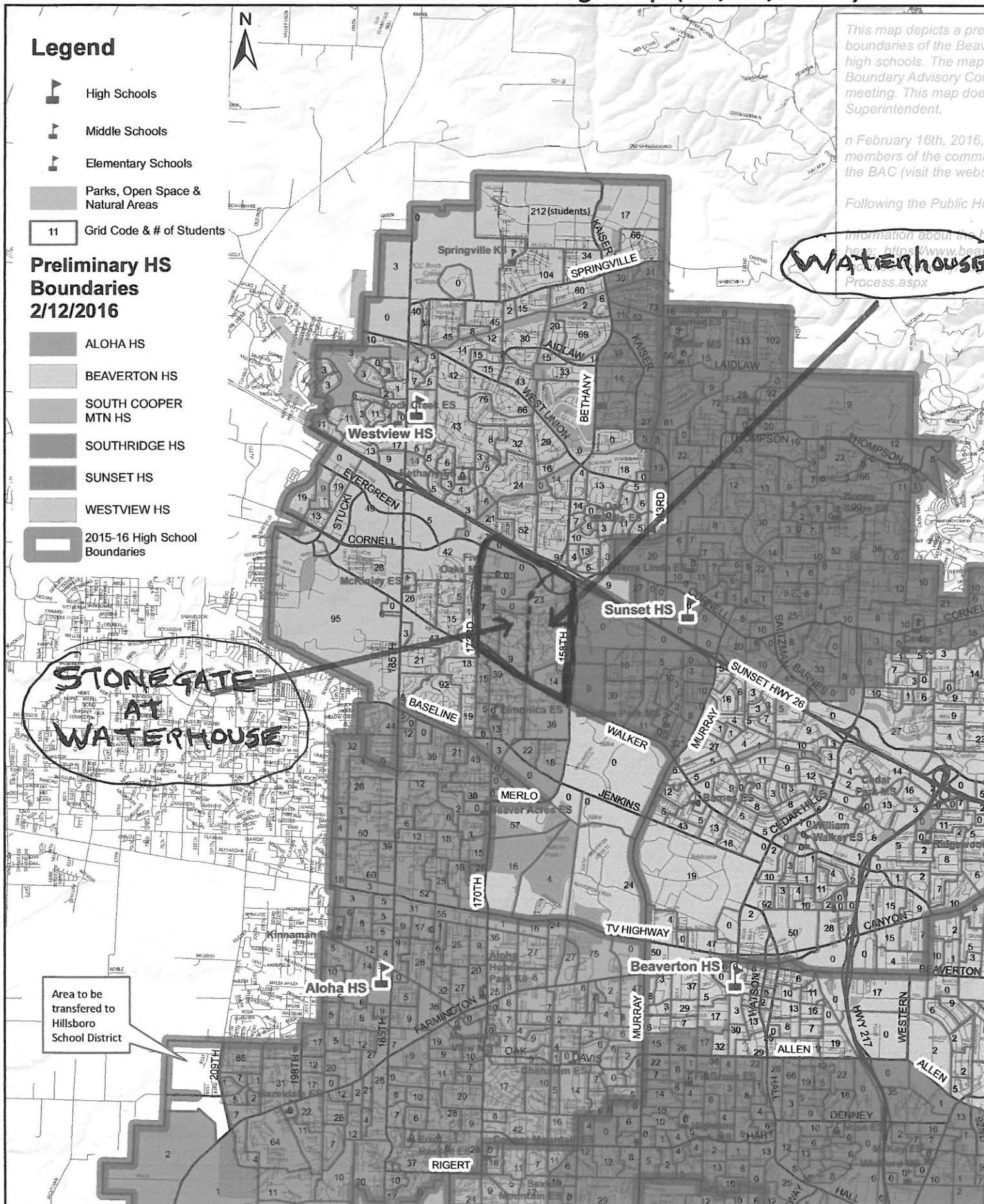

If school capacity considerations are bothering you, why not move the mobile home community (off baseline) into the Aloha HS?









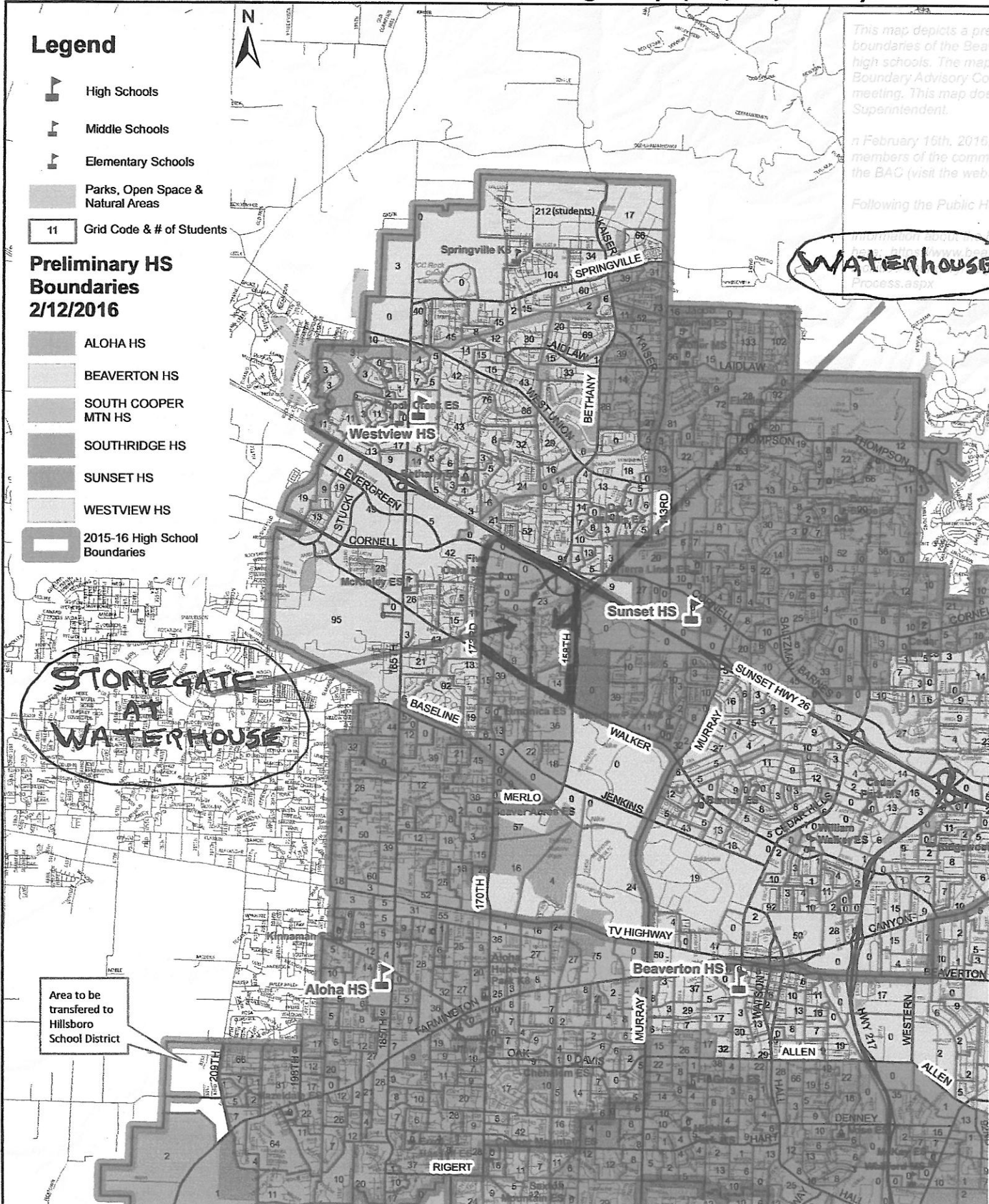

Dear Members of the H.S. Boundary Committee,

Our neighborhood is the Stonegate portion of the Waterhouse North community. It is bordered by Cornell Rd. on the north, NW 158th on the east, Walker Rd on the south, and NW 173rd Ave on the west. Despite appearing moderately large geographically, it contains only a few (53) forecasted high school students.

Members of our neighborhood have been diligently attending every single meeting throughout the boundary change process. We fully understand the complexity of this epic change and sympathize with the challenges therein.

We have all vocalized our support of the initial Springboard Proposal which moved us from our currently assigned High School of Westview to Sunset. A later revision moved us back to Westview – which all of us also supported and conveyed this with our e-mails and comments. Being a smaller community, we didn't rally with petitions and map proposals because it was not needed at the time as the criteria between being assigned to either Westview or Sunset made sense. However, on February 11th it became apparent that a variety of map change proposals were brought forward for consideration which ultimately resulted in our neighborhood being reassigned to Aloha High School. The last minute shift, on February 11th, to a school significantly farther away, has us deeply concerned.

The change to Aloha conflicts with a couple of the most important criteria that the BAC is utilizing. Namely, transportation-proximity and transportation-safety. Students from our neighborhood will face a particularly challenging commute toward 185th where a left turn is taken and then a gauntlet of major intersections and two rail tracks (MAX and Union Pacific) are navigated. Ironically, this commute goes through other neighborhoods that are closer in proximity to Aloha than ours – yet are assigned to Westview. During peak traffic times this nearly 4 ½ mile stretch would take significantly longer compared to the commute to either Westview or Sunset – at more than double the distance. Not to mention, this route is less pedestrian-friendly compared to Sunset or Westview. Google Maps shows a walk time of almost 1 hour and 10 minutes along busy routes transected by many timed cross signals.

We are also concerned that this would inhibit the ability to participate in pre and post-school extra-curricular activities.

We have drafted our own map proposals with two solutions to rectify this situation. One involves splitting the neighborhood at a major power-line/greenspace with one portion attending Sunset (37) and the other Westview (16) – this proposal creates very minimal impact to the numbers of either school.

The second solution would place the whole neighborhood (53) in either Sunset or Westview. To accomplish this we proposed some very minor shifts from current Westview neighborhoods that are closer to Aloha than ours and also a minor shift from current Sunset neighborhoods who could easily attend Beaverton.

We would be very grateful if you could kindly consider the above information and solutions.

~~Good evening.~~ My name is Elizabeth Moreno and I live in Stonegate, a neighborhood north of Walker Road that has been in the Westview boundary since Westview first opened.

I have been an active participant in this process since October, attending 7 of 10 meetings and submitting comments when appropriate. We know that school capacity is the main reason for the boundary changes and lots of kids will have to switch schools. Therefore, we were willing to make room at Westview and switch to Sunset when the Springboard Proposal made that change. After all, Sunset is closer, and proximity to school was one of the school board's main criteria given to the committee at the very first meeting.

The next few maps put us back at Westview and we were happy to see that there were a number of different options that made enough room for us to stay. We love Westview and it is still very close to our neighborhood. My son has walked home from Westview several times and the 2.5 mile walk keeps him on sidewalks and pedestrian only paths.

Both Westview and Sunset make sense for our neighborhood.

So I was shocked that towards the end of a lengthy, thoughtful process, the Public Hearing Map has us suddenly placed at the top of a narrow boundary for Aloha HS, the third farthest school from our neighborhood. On this map, we are surrounded on three sides by Westview and Sunset neighbors. To get to Aloha, our kids would have to be bussed through neighborhoods to the southwest that are still zoned for Westview.

I am trying to understand why maps made by community members may have been considered in the decision to pull us into Aloha. These maps represent the desires of a small section of the district but not the district as a whole. Most importantly, by putting us in Aloha, they don't follow the criteria.

Sending us to Aloha violates many of the top criteria: proximity to school, neighborhood unity and transportation safety. It also means higher transportation costs. I urge you to apply the criteria set by the school board and put us back in Westview or Sunset.
