



Phase II: Update from Supt. Jeff Rose - April 18, 2016

I am continuing my review of the High School Boundary Committee's Recommendations. I met with the Technical Team this past week to discuss some additional information the School Board asked to be included in the materials that will be presented to them when I make my recommendation at the April 25, 2016 School Board Meeting. I have also asked the Boundary Committee for some additional feedback on the boundary map and the transition recommendations.

The following are some of the general themes of the comments I have received from the community in the last week:

Boundaries

- **Aloha HS-** concerns for the physical state of the building
- **Beaverton HS-** keep Ridgewood ES at Sunset HS
- **Oak Hills ES-** keep Oak Hills community together and attending Sunset HS; Keep Oak Hills community together and continue their attendance at Westview HS
- **Raleigh Hills-** keep Raleigh Hills community together
- **Ridgewood ES-** Ridgewood ES community has been vocal and solution-oriented creating maps to help BSD with boundary recommendations; keep West TV going to Beaverton HS
- **Waterhouse Neighborhood-** move this neighborhood to a closer high school; Waterhouse II neighborhoods should go to Westview or Sunset not Aloha
- **West TV-** safety concerns and distance to Beaverton HS vs. Sunset HS; keep West TV at Sunset HS
- **Other-** keep middle schools whole and going to one high school

Transitions:

- Let students finish where they start; allow administrative transfers for students who are in IB or AP
- **Juniors & Seniors-** support for grandfathering juniors and seniors
- **Sophomores-** let sophomores stay at their current school
- **Siblings-** allow siblings to attend high school with older siblings
