- Students must comply with BPSD Proof of Residence requirements and be registered at their school of residence/current school before requesting a transfer to another school. **Students attending BPSD on an Interdistrict Transfer permit may not request an Intradistrict Transfer permit.**
- BPSD shall have no responsibility with regard to transportation outside the school of residence.
- Applications received between January 11, 2021-February 11, 2021 will receive priority consideration. Applications received on/after February 11, 2021 will not be given priority status (and may not be considered until August when enrollment numbers are stabilized).
- Once an Intradistrict Transfer permit is approved, the student will continue at the requested school through the completion of 5<sup>th</sup> grade for elementary and 8<sup>th</sup> grade for middle school unless the Intradistrict Transfer permit is revoked.
- Approved Intradistrict Transfers may be revoked for 1) unsatisfactory attendance, 2) citizenship/behavior, 3) providing false information in making a transfer request, and 4) other reasons that may be determined by district policy and the Board of Education.
