Currently 292 students, more students enrolling at term (mainly upper-class students)

Topic 2 Upcoming Fieldtrips

Can now check on how many assignments kids have submitted on an add-in to Canvas. This will be very helpful for advisors in discussions with their students.

Mascot--Hannah De La Cruz

Polar Bears won from 149 surveys received from students (both in first and second place)

Graphic Design—various options

Positive Behavior Interventions System (PBIS)—would like to incorporate

Innovations Polar Bear Build own PBIS Ex. Words for each

Key themes to include: Participation, Emotional piece, Being Kind to each other

January—Winter Dance Spirit week, would like to reveal school mascot then

Survey response rate—was done through Canvas with a Banner, very impressive

Fees—Stacey Briggs

- Current fees--\$10 textbook fee (also for computers) \$20 Activity Fee (can be up to \$30)
- Computers and technology up to \$20 \$10 computer fee \$8000 = total fees in 2021
- All money gets spent on kids
- 60 new laptops—has been a work in progress and just received grant for them
- Percentage of students on waivers—40% have applied (more are probably eligible)
- Every fee waiver has to show documents; need to bring in to show to Stacey
- School goal of 350 enrollment
- Payment by check or cash—need the ability pay online
- Option for families to pay for other families fees?
- Foundation at \$2k now
- If got a big donor—could be a way to fund trip to D.C.
- How to show activities?
- Idea—welcome care package for online students to help them feel welcome and feel part of the community, put something in there with the new mascot
- Could ask for donations instead of increasing fees
- Allowed to do fundraisers? 1 per year
- Do not currently have a parent arm working on fundraising
- Propose to move fees to \$15 computers \$25 Activity fee = \$40 total
- When was last time fees were raised? Unknown.
- Promote the foundation—let parents know if they are interested in donating

What filters are used? Iboss Ex. Can search if someone trying to find ways to kill themselves, Get counselor Nicole and work with student

YouTube—blocked for students

Can see what students are working on

What resources does the district provide? Acceptable Use Policy

Inappropriate content—will be reported, websites reviewed and blocked; students can lose internet privileges

How devices are being used? Canvas and Internet; phones not able to monitor

Supervision—Filter, students learning to manage themselves

Students feel more interactive, positive feeling in the building, feels better; trying to work together and be positive

Ideas—Question about students leaving early—any progress on that?
