A Safety and Security meeting was held Wednesday, December 15, 2021 beginning at 1:00 PM via Zoom. The following committee members were present: Chief Dareing, Randolph Adami, Chris Gonzalez, Troy Neal, Matthew Krajnovich, Pam Goodson, Karen Heeth, and Britney Sauer.

Chief Dareing called the meeting to order at 1:10 PM. He noted that the majority of the committee were in attendance via Zoom and a quorum was present.

Chief Dareing welcomed the committee and each member stated their name.

II. Discussion Items


- A. The first item discussed was the Opening of Schools-Health and Safety presented by Randolph Adami. At this time there was 43 active COVID cases in the District with no large spike after the Thanksgiving break but be ready for a spike after the Christmas break. Vaccination clinics have been offered on the weekends. There has been an uptick in mental health issues and behavioral problems. PD is adding an additional full-time Mental Health Officer to handle call load.
- B. The second item discussed was presented by Lt. Krajnovich with an EOP Update. Final report comes out after all updates have been completed. HCDE handles the Audit.
- C. The third item discussed was an update on the Smart School Project Integration at Terrace Elementary presented by Troy Neal. There have been some road blocks to integration. Will be adding additional ASR emergency buttons to facilities as well as a weapon detection system (Zero Eyes) at Stratford High School, then NBHS, MHS, and SWHS. .
- D. The fourth item discussed was the Emergency Notification System/ERS Radios presented by Chief Dareing. A new notification system will be implemented around the end of January 2022 which allows information to be sent out via text throughout a circular area.
