Meetings: Committee Meetings are open to the public. The meeting schedule is posted on the webpage.

Comments/Input: Public input and comments will be welcome throughout the process. There will be no public comment taken during the Committee meetings. Comments/input may be sent here: Boundary-Adjustment-Comments@beaverton.k12.or.us. The Committee will review all public comments/input at each meeting.

Meeting summaries will be provided by Withycombe & Scotten (Dick Withycombe is the facilitator of the process) following each meeting. Once the meeting summaries are approved by the Committee, they will be posted to the high school boundary webpage and shared through multiple communications channels.

Public Preview: (January 21, 2016) The committee will conduct a Public Preview to give parents and community members an opportunity to review and comment on the preliminary High School Boundary recommendations.

Formal Public Hearing: (February 18, 2016) The committee will conduct a formal hearing regarding the High School Boundary and transition recommendations. The Committee will review and adjust the recommendations in response to the input given at the hearing and email comments.

Constituent Concerns via phone or email: The Communications & Community Involvement Dept. will manage constituent concerns. Additional materials and communications will be developed in response to Committee and community needs.
