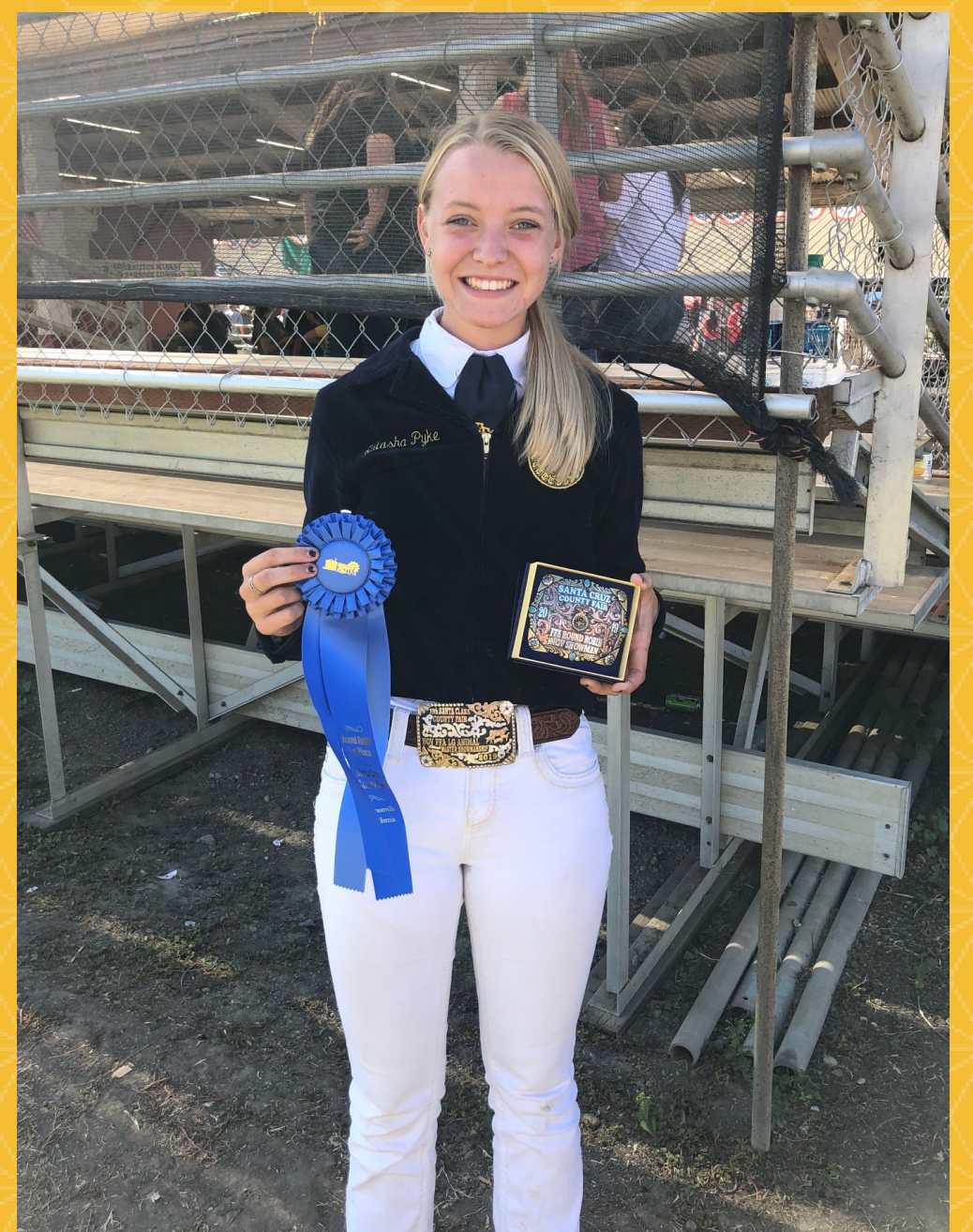

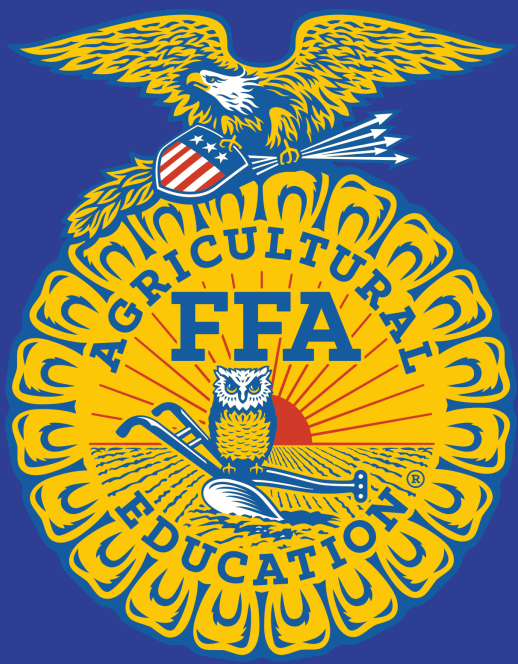

What is FFA?

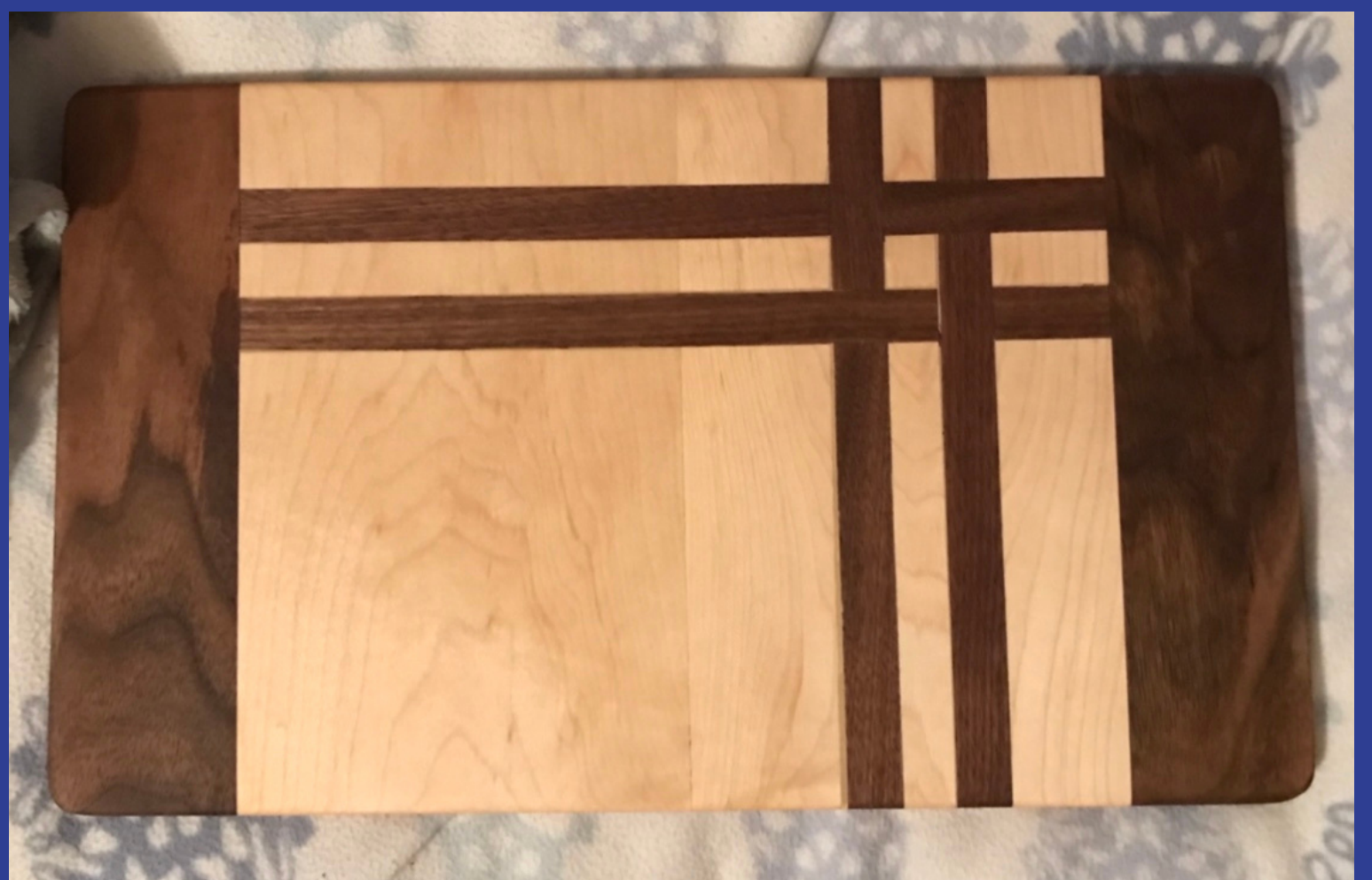
FFA is an intracurricular student organization for those interested in agriculture and leadership. It is one of the three components of agricultural education.

MORE THAN JUST A PROJECT



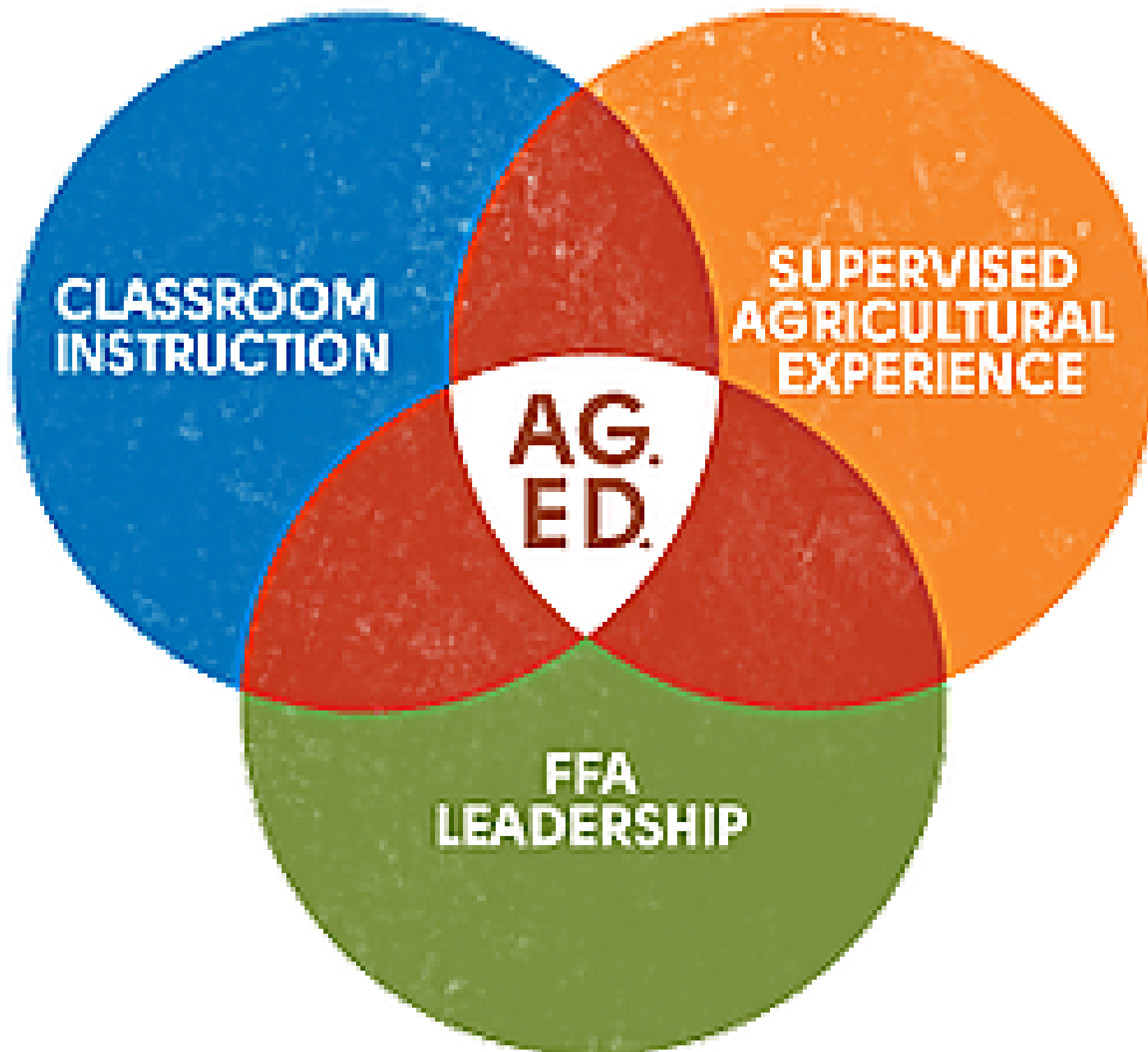
What is an SAE project?
