

❖ If you are <u>currently enrolled</u> in an Athletic Sport, Band, Drill Team and wish to continue during 10th grade year; you can select the course for one of the elective choices.

Example: Football 2, Band 2, Drill Team 2

If you <u>are not currently enrolled</u> in an Athletic Sport, Band, Drill Team this year; <u>you cannot select the course</u>. Once you tryout for the Team/Band with the coach/teacher and make the team, your 9th grade Counselor will enroll you in the course. Please don't select the course, because if you do; your counselor will select an elective from your endorsement pathway.

The Arts & Humanities Endorsement can be earned by taking a coherent sequence of courses directly related to fine and performing arts, political science, world languages, cultural studies, and English literature.

Six Options: A) A total of five social studies courses

B) Four levels of the same language in a language other than English

C) Two levels of the same language in a language other than English and two levels of a different language in a language other than English

D) Four levels of American Sign Language

E) A coherent sequence of four credits by selecting courses from one or two categories or disciplines in fine arts or innovative courses

F) Four English Elective credits The Business & Industry Endorsement can be earned by taking a coherent sequence of courses directly related to the following:

(B) Four credits in each of the four foundation subject areas to include English IV and chemistry and/or physics.


(C) Four credits in Advanced Placement or dual credit selected from English, mathematics, science, social studies, economics, languages other than English, or fine arts
