Dear Parents, Guardians, and Community-at-large,

The information below will update you on the current Covid-19 conditions at Eastern Lancaster County School District. Currently our case counts are as follows: *(as of Friday, 1/7/2022 9:23 a.m.)*

**Blue Ball Elementary**

Total 13 positive cases – 5 staff, 8 learners (5 in the building during infectious period)

**Brecknock Elementary**

Total 6 positive cases - 3 staff, 3 learners (0 in the building during infectious period)

**New Holland Elementary**

Total 9 positive cases - 5 staff, 4 learners (2 in the building during infectious period)

**Garden Spot Secondary Campus (7-12)**

Total 33 positive cases – 6 staff, 27 learners (16 in the building during infectious period)

We will continue to monitor our Covid-19 case numbers and will do our best to communicate with you as conditions change in the District. We plan to do our best to avoid virtual learning, however, with the current Covid spike, we are again experiencing severe shortages of adults to safely conduct school operations and may need to switch to remote learning on short notice. Please stay tuned to District communications such as “Remind”, the website, and make sure your contact information, especially phone numbers are up to date. We continue to need assistance in multiple support staff and substitute teacher positions. Please consider joining our family!
