# Final Exams for Seniors (April 11 - 14)

This year, Senior final exams will be held during the week of April 11, which will allow Seniors the time to complete their Christian Service requirements by May 12. *Please note: Seniors in Advanced Placement courses will remain in their AP courses until their AP exam is taken.* 

Senior final exams will take place Monday, April 11 through Thursday, April 14. Finals are taken in core courses only and students with an 85% average or better are exempt. There are no final exams in Advancement Placement (AP) courses but, as mentioned above, students taking Advanced Placement (AP) courses must take the corresponding AP exam.

# Senior Christian Service (April 25 – May 12)

Service Hours Required – Students with No AP Classes

Christian Service requirements for students with no Advanced Placement classes:

• Seniors who are not enrolled in AP courses must complete their 90 hours of service between the weeks of April 25 – May 12.

### Service Hours Required – Students with AP Classes

The Christian Service hours to meet our graduation requirements are based upon the student's schedule:

• Seniors with one or two AP courses are required to complete a minimum of 70 hours by May 12.

• Seniors with three or more AP courses are required to complete a minimum of 50 hours by May 12.
