Week of January 3rd---

Welcome Back to School in the Deep, Dark of Winter! May it snow and snow! (We need the water!)

This week's Library Lesson:

DRAGONS & The Dewey Decimal System - Where Can I Find the Drawing Books?

Students K-5 will be given an overview of the Dewey System with a focus on the 700's. Drawing Dragons & other characters will be the activity.

Fourth & Fifth Graders will be introduced to the Guardians of Ga'Hoole series.

Sixth Graders will continue their research on their chosen 20th Century topic. Students will be guided in how to create a "Works Cited" page at the end of their ppt and how to insert MLA citations onto the page. Students will then have the next three weeks to finish gathering their information, paraphrase & type up that information into their slideshows, and have that information edited, working on the steps needed in good research! Computer Lab and any other free time may be used to find good facts on the chosen topic.
