EPHS Advanced Placement Exam Registration 2021-22

Advanced Placement (AP) exam registration is in two parts:

- 1. <u>Join your College Board AP class sections</u>: Enroll with the College Board into a class section for each AP exam you plan to take. See the attached information for instructions or go to <u>myap.collegeboard.org</u>. Important: verify that "YES" is selected from the drop-down menu under the heading "Order Exam." That allows EPHS to order your AP exams. Join codes are also online at https://www.edenpr.org/eden-prairie-high-school/academics/academic-programs/apcis. EP Online students if your section is not listed, use "No Course Taken" as your section.
- Pay for your AP exams: Your AP registration is not complete until you pay for your exams. Payment is online beginning now through November 1, 2021, and continues with late fees (as listed below) until March 1, 2022. Go to our secure vendor website directly to register for the AP exams:

 If you are approved for the Federal Free or Reduced-Price Lunch Program at EPHS, answer "yes" to the question to request an AP needs-based scholarship.

Additional AP Exam Registration Information:

Exam dates: May 2-13, 2022. The College Board is offering in-person paper AP exams this year (except for AP Chinese and Japanese exams). Morning exams at EPHS begin early at 8:00 a.m. and conclude at approximately 12:15 p.m. Afternoon exams begin at 12:15 p.m. and conclude late, at approximately 4:30 p.m. (depending on the exam). The exam length is the time of the exam plus one hour for administrative items (e.g., bubbling in answer sheets, breaks, instructions). The College Board does not allow students to leave the exam early. You are responsible for transportation beyond normal school hours. The College Board website has information about Advanced Placement exams in general and the calendar dates for each exam this year at www.collegeboard.org.

<u>Exam fees</u>: \$80 per exam (full cost is \$115 per exam; the state provides a subsidy for \$35 of the \$96 College Board AP exam fee; EPHS charges an additional \$19 per exam to cover expenses for proctoring, student review sessions, table and chair rental, and AP scholar recognition).

<u>Late fees</u>: The College Board has initiated new administrative deadlines. There is a \$40 late fee per exam ordered or cancelled after Monday, November 1, 2021. If your AP course begins during Terms 2 or 3, the late fee is waived (since the College Board has a "spring" registration season for these courses). The last day to order an AP exam is Tuesday, March 1, 2022. EP Online students – any "No Course Taken" section must be paid for by Nov. 1 to avoid College Board late fees.

<u>Late exams</u>: If you have scheduling problems for an AP exam or you miss your scheduled exam, contact Mr. Rollin in Student Center South as soon as possible. A late exam may be available May 17 - 20 under very limited circumstances. Significant additional fees may apply.

<u>Testing Accommodations</u> (e.g., extra time required, Braille test): Students with IEP plans should see their case manager to discuss the possibility of testing accommodations for AP exams. Students with 504 plans should see their counselor to discuss the possibility of testing accommodations for AP exams. Students must submit testing accommodations requests to Mr. Rollin no later than December 16, 2021.

<u>Non-EPHS Students</u>: Non-EPHS students are welcome to register for EPHS AP exams, but if no EPHS student registers for an exam by November 1, 2021, then the exam will be canceled and refunded. AP Chinese and Japanese exams are limited to EPHS or EP Online students only.




