### OVERVIEW

Founded in 1956, Notre Dame High School is a private Catholic coeducational college-preparatory high school and welcomes students of all religious, ethnic, and socioeconomic backgrounds. Notre Dame's campus environment is centered on the school's charism of Cor Unum et Anima Una—One Heart and One Spirit—and prepares students for a life of **faith, academic success, and community engagement**. Recognized as an **Apple Distinguished School** in 2021, Notre Dame's one-to-one iPad learning environment encourages students to innovate beyond the classroom and apply real-world learning on their journey to innovate, create, learn, and grow.

### ACCREDITATIONS

Notre Dame is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and the Western Catholic Educational Association (WCEA) and holds memberships with the National Catholic Educational Association (NCEA) and College Board.



### CURRICULUM & GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

#### SCHEDULE

- The school year includes: Two semesters comprised of approximately 18 weeks (9-week quarters).
- Block Schedule: All classes meet three times per week
  - Mondays: All class periods meet for 45-minutes
  - Tuesday-Friday: 75-minute class periods

# PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

## ALTHETICS

Notre Dame offers 17 CIF team sports in the fall, winter, and spring seasons. Athletic team tryouts are held during each season, with opportunities for students to participate in multiple sports. In 2021, six teams earned Highest Team GPA in Riverside County.

## STUDENT LEADERSHIP

Student leadership organizations such as ASB, Peer Ministry, and the Student Ambassador Program directly impact student life on campus. Through specialty events, retreats, and more, student leaders engage, encourage, and lead their peers with purpose and responsibility.

## MOCK TRIAL

Founded in 2017, the Notre Dame Mock Trial Team has had tremendous success as a program. Coached by ND Alumni, the team has earned Elite 8 placement in the Riverside County Mock Trial Competition since 2018 and a top 3 placement in 2021. Mock Trial students have garnered two internships with the D.A.'s office and have been named best Clerk and Pre-Trial Attorney.

## CLUB & ACTIVITIES

Students have multiple opportunities to get involved, as highlighted in our 85% participation rate in clubs, athletics, or other campus activity.

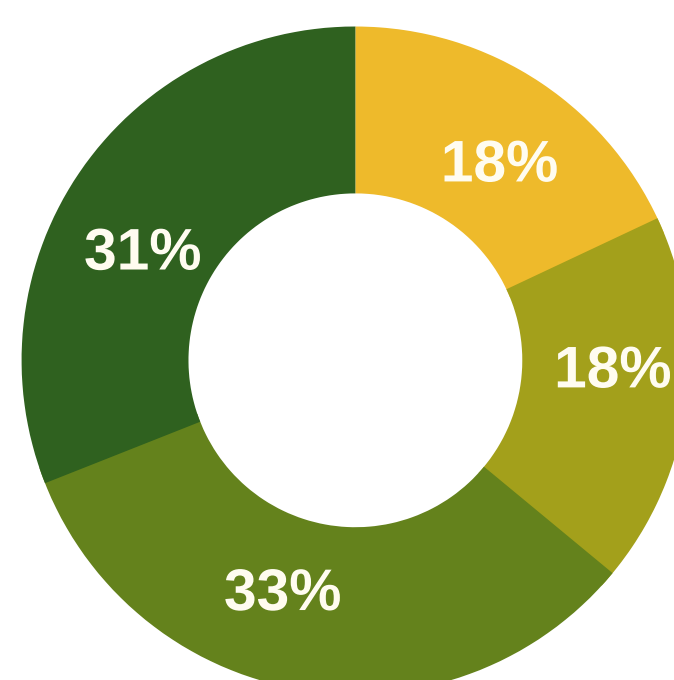
