



## Environmental Safety Indoor Air Quality

- Central York has utilized ACIA to complete yearly testing of IAQ since 2013. There are currently no requirements for schools to test IAQ, however the EPA does have recommendations regarding air quality in schools.
- In all years tested, air quality has scored good or above.
- Current air testing detects fibers, dander, pollen and the following organisms.

- Central York follows the EPA recommended use of a minimum of MERV 8 air filters which are changed every 6 months.
- ACIA completed a test for VOC's utilizing a TO-15 Summa Cannister in February 2019, showing levels for 120 chemical compounds.
