Administration- Report on School Improvement Goals

Reading Growth K-6

Seventy percent of students in grades K-6 will achieve typical or above typical growth as measured by Acadience Pathways of Progress from Middle of Year to Middle of Year.

Reading Comprehension 3-6

In grades 3-6, increase student proficiency or above proficiency by 2% in reading comprehension as measured by the Reading Inventory.

Math Growth 1-6

Seventy-five percent of students in grades 1-6 will meet typical or above growth from the Beginning of the Year to the End of Year on the iReady Diagnostics Growth Report.

STEM

Eighty percent of students will show proficiency in grade level science standards as measured by pre and post tests of each standard 1-6.

Eighty percent of students will increase in Coding proficiency as measured by benchmark pre and post term.
