## Notes from the Office

#### **Quarantining Protocols**

**Student tests positive-5** day quarantine **Close Contact (vaccinated)-** no quarantine required if no symptoms **Close Contact (unvaccinated)-5** day quarantine

Students are eligible for remote access to instruction if they have tested positive or if they are a close contact to someone that has tested positive. Please contact the main office if this situation occurs for your student. Remote instruction looks different this year--those approved students will be able log in and observe the class. It is not expected that the teacher interact all day with any student on remote.

#### Waiting for Results of a Test?

Please <u>do not</u> send your student to school if you are awaiting test results. Please contact the main office with any questions.

#### Updated Health Records

Please ensure all updated health records are sent to the health office. This includes any records of COVID-19 vaccinations.

#### Travelling?




