English

In English this week, the children will be using their research to write a fact file all about their chosen animal. The children will be using headings, subheadings and paragraphs to organise their information.

The children will continue to develop their knowledge and understanding of how conjunctions can be used to extend sentences.

Maths

In Maths this week, the children are going to begin to develop their understanding of fractions. We will introduce this concept by describing fractions as being an equal part of a whole. The children will explore the value of a half compared to a whole.

To support their understanding of this, there are fraction games on purple mash and we have set the following activities on Mathletics for your child to complete if you wish.
